

## CAVITY PROTECTION

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Our teeth are always being covered with a sticky film of bacteria called plaque. When we eat or drink sugar or starch such as milk, bread, cookies, candy, soda, juice, or fruit – bacteria turns the sugar and starch into acids that can attack tooth enamel. For most people, repeated acid attacks eventually result in decay.

One of the most common places that tooth decay develops is on the chewing surface of the back teeth. When you run your tongue along these chewing surfaces, you can feel depressions and grooves. These indentations, called pits and fissures, help to grind food.

Regular brushing and cleaning between teeth with floss helps remove food particles and bacteria from the smooth surfaces of tooth enamel. However, pits and fissures are difficult to keep clean.

Brush twice a day with a fluoride toothpaste and clean between teeth once a day with floss or another interdental cleaner. Schedule regular dental visits and avoid frequent between-meal snacks.
